VERMILION, Ohio – <u>ClevelandBallet</u> dancers have returned to the studio after a summer hiatus and will open their 2024-2025 season with "Encore in Vermilion." The event takes place at 6 p.m., Saturday, September 21, with a wine and appetizer reception and continues with an outdoor performance at 7 p.m.

Ticket holders will enjoy a mix of classical and contemporary selections. These include the Prologue from "Sleeping Beauty," and "Walpurgisnacht" from Charles Gounod's interpretation of "Faust." Works from Cleveland Ballet's ChoreoLab, a showcase of the dancers' choreography, will be part of the show.

The event takes place at Harbourtown Fine Arts Center, 736Main Street, Vermilion.
